In consultation with the Program Manager, the Residential Care Worker provides nursing assistance, personal care, community leisure programs, companionship, housekeeping duties and support to persons with disabilities living in a group home, while providing a safe, natural, clean, home-like environment. Encourages the clients to be as independent as possible and to achieve an active, productive and rewarding lifestyle, by working side by side with the clients, implementing positive, creative experiences to enhance clients quality of life. The key worker works with all the residents, with key responsibilities of one specific resident, writing monthly reports and contributing to the care plan of the resident.
